This is precisely the reason why this movie has lost its narrative depth and breadth.

Narrative logic is difficult to generate new ideas

The captivating story and complementary narrative style can help the audience maintain a sense of "presence" at all times. This "presence" is an important link connecting the emotions of the audience and the protagonist of the work. The outstanding narrative style undoubtedly drives the plot and can better control the emotions and psychological state of the audience, highlighting a higher level of dramatic tension. However, 'Reverse Scale' appears to be inadequate in this regard. The overall rhythm of the film is chaotic and dragging, as if it has fallen into an inescapable quagmire. The handling of many plot points is like a wheel spinning in the mud, which can be explained in just one sentence, but is forcefully elaborated with a lot of space. For example, in the duet between Shen Teng and Zhang Yuqi, Mr. Huang asked Shen Teng's character Zunfei to pay attention to his lover's abnormal behavior of smiling, which clearly points to Zunfei's character relationship with Zhang Yuqi. However, the film later spent a lot of time laying the groundwork for this already looming truth, especially the dialogue scenes on the mountain. The two were repeatedly entangled in lengthy conversations, which not only failed to add suspense, but also turned the originally tense and exciting gangster crime story into a stinky and long romance drama in an instant. What's even more awkward is that the combination of Shen Teng and Zhang Yuqi feels extremely discordant when performing such emotional scenes, and their conversations and physical interactions seem to be out of place with the character settings and film atmosphere.
